This document shows my research, inspiration and early logo concepts ready for refinement into a final design.





LOGO CONCEPT ONE:

BOLD ICON

This concept takes a bold font, customises it subtly so it isn't 'off the shelf' and adds a bold, modern icon based on the head of the titular zebra. I also quite like the font-only version, with the icon too.

This idea is born from a couple of thoughts. Firstly, a zebra's pattern is almost barcode-esque, and secondly, it lends itself to identification/labelling.






























BLUE ZEBRA
